Biographical Sketch

Martha Innis Young was born in Poughkeepsie, New York in 1856, the first child of George Innis (1822-1903) and Anne Bevier Hasbrouck Innis (1827-1906). Her father, George Innis, was a partner in the firm of Gifford, Sherman & Innis, which specialized in manufacturing dye extracts; he also served as mayor of the City of Poughkeepsie from 1863 to 1869. Anne Innis, Martha's mother, was a member of a prominent landowning family in Ulster County, New York. Martha, fondly called Mattie, Doll, or Dolly by her family, had one brother, Hasbrouck Innis (1859-1932), with whom she remained close throughout her life. The beautiful daughter of a wealthy and influential family, Martha Innis was a fixture in Poughkeepsie society.

Martha Innis was educated at Bockie Seminary, Poughkeepsie (1866-1870) and Mrs. Sylvanus Reed's French & English Boarding School in New York City. From 1874 to 1876, she studied at Vassar College in Poughkeepsie, where her father was a trustee.

On May 16, 1883, Martha Innis married William Hopkins Young (1855-1909) at the Reformed Church in Poughkeepsie. William was the son Henry Lathrop Young and Mary Eliot Dwight Young, and was born at Cedarwood, an estate on South Hamilton Street in Poughkeepsie. Mr. Young received his law degree from Columbia University in 1881, and after the young couple married he established the law firm of Young & Phinney (later Young, VerPlanck & Prince) in Manhattan.

Mr. and Mrs. Young had three children – Annette (1885-1975), Innis (1887-1953) and Eliot (1892-1894). The Young family resided at Rosewood, Mrs. Young's parents' home, until 1895 when they moved to Locust Grove, a large estate beautifully situated on the Hudson River just south of Poughkeepsie. Mr. and Mrs. Young rented the estate during the summer months from the heirs of Samuel F. B. Morse, the artist and inventor of the telegraph who designed the mansion and laid the grounds in the 1850's. After moving to Locust Grove in 1895 and remodeling the house in 1901, Mrs. Young was able to entertain on a lavish scale. Since Mr. Young's law firm was located in New York City, the family also maintained an apartment at 501 Fifth Avenue.

Mrs. Young was a member of numerous associations and clubs and contributed her time, energy and money to many charities, especially the American Red Cross and the Galluadet Home for the Deaf. She took great interest in the gardens of Locust Grove, communicating with nurseries all over the country to enlarge and beautify the flower gardens. She was also an enthusiastic and informed collector of American furniture and decorative arts and acquired through inheritance or purchase many of the pieces displayed at Locust Grove today. Mrs. Young traveled frequently with her husband both in the United States and, more often, in Europe.

After her husband's death in 1909, Mrs. Young remained at Locust Grove with her daughter and her son. Her social activities continued, though the grand garden parties and concerts (mentioned in letters and diaries during the first decade of the century) were replaced with more intimate gatherings for her whist club "The Owls" or afternoon tea parties.

Martha Young died on October 23, 1946 and is buried in the Young family plot at the Poughkeepsie Rural Cemetery.

Scope and Content Note

The papers of Martha Innis Young are section of the larger Young Family Archives, which are in turn a component of the primary museum collection at Locust Grove. In 1975 Mrs. Young's daughter, Annette Innis Young, bequeathed all her personal property, including these archives, to found the museum. Her family papers were scattered throughout the mansion and outbuildings, and in the late 1970's an attempt was made by staff and volunteers to organize part of the Young Collection. This attempt was not systematic and, in fact, overlooked several hundred boxes of archival material which remained inaccessible until the late 1990's. Between 1998 and 2010, with partial funding from the New York State Archives through the Documentary Heritage Program, the Young Family Archives were removed from boxes, drawers and closets throughout the historic mansion and organized in a new storage facility in the Visitor Center to ensure their preservation and promote increased public access.

Martha Young's papers include correspondence, diaries, bills and receipts, cancelled checks, legal documents, insurance papers, tax records, and ephemera. Mrs. Young was convinced that her family's history was important and worth preserving, and she saved papers of every variety to document both her own life, and those of her relatives and ancestors. She also instilled in her children a love for history and preservation that led them to establish museums to maintain their family history.

In general, artificial series and arrangement groupings have been created, since no discernable order from the creator was evident. See the arrangement note for more information about arrangement by series.

Series Description

Series 1: Correspondence (1862-1946) 70 Boxes

Spanning the years from 1862 to 1946, Martha Young's correspondence consists of letters written to and from her family and friends. These letters concern her education, her social activities, and especially her domestic life at Locust Grove. The correspondence is filed in chronological order, followed by undated material. The bulk of the correspondence consists of letters written to Mrs. Young since she made few copies of her outgoing correspondence. The letters were preserved by Mrs. Young and later by her daughter Annette Young at the family home, Locust Grove.

Mrs. Young's early correspondence generally consists of social notes between herself and friends in Poughkeepsie and New York City. Some of the letters take on a wider range after her marriage in 1883. The large household she supervised, first at her family home Rosewood and later at Locust Grove required an enormous amount of supplies. Correspondence with food markets, hardware stores, shops specializing in furniture, wall papers, fabrics, china, glass, books, household linens, silversmiths is most prevalent in the series. There is correspondence with department stores and jewelers and a great deal of correspondence, in French, with dressmakers in New York City. There is also a continuing series of letters exchanged with numerous nurseries throughout the country.

The correspondence indicates that Mrs. Young was a member of numerous clubs and associations including: the New York State Historical Association, the Huguenot Society of America, the New York Genealogy & Biographical Society, the American Museum of Natural History, the Gallaudet Home in Wappingers Falls, the New England Historic Genealogical Society, the Millbrook Garden Club, and the New York State Whist Association.

Of particular note is the voluminous correspondence with her son, Innis Young, both from his home in Connecticut and from abroad, featuring excellent descriptions of the countries and cultures that he saw. There are also letters from Martha Innis Young's daughter, Annette Young, especially greeting cards and postcards. There are many sympathy notes from friends and family upon the deaths of Martha Innis Young's mother (1906), her infant son (1894), her husband (1909), and her brother, Hasbrouck Innis (1932). Upon the death of her husband, Mrs. Young began to correspond with his law partner, William Gordon Ver Planck; these letters detail the property that she inherited and especially the investments that she held. Letters frequently discuss illnesses of family and friends, genealogy and family history, and especially financial matters and stock interests.

Christmas and other greeting cards form a significant portion of this collection, filed by year where possible and otherwise by subject with the undated correspondence at the end of the series.

Series 2: Personal Papers 78 Boxes

Martha Innis Young's personal papers, like her correspondence, were part of Annette Innis Young's 1975 bequest founding the museum at Locust Grove. They consist of a wide variety of materials arranged alphabetically by subject. In general, because these papers were dispersed throughout the Locust Grove mansion and were not arranged by their creator, unless otherwise noted subject categories have been artificially created to improve access. The Personal Papers series includes the following major subseries.

Bills are arranged alphabetically and were transferred from the expanding alphabetical file folders in which Mrs. Young arranged them, for example laundry bills from a number of different companies are all filed under "L." While original order was retained, Mrs. Young's alphabetical order is not always accurate. Files include bills from other family members including Annette Innis Young, Hasbrouck Innis and William Hopkins Young that were paid by Mrs. Young. All bills not arranged by Mrs. Young are arranged chronologically. After Mr. Young died in 1909, Mrs. Young administered most of the family finances and her bills increase as a result.

The **Estate of Martha Innis Young** refers to documentation regarding the probate and dissolution of personal and real property after her death.

Mrs. Young's papers include several boxes of **Garden Catalogs** dating between 1880 and 1940; many include notes and annotations regarding seed and plant orders.

Several folders of **Newspaper clippings** were carefully saved by Mrs. Young and include a wide variety of topics including obituaries, social announcements, local history, and world history.

Arrangement Note

In general, artificial categories have been created for the Young Family Archives in general and the Martha Innis Young Papers in particular. However, some overall trends present in the Young Archives were used as the basis for these categories.

Correspondence

Letters in the Young Family Archives were often grouped chronologically and so this arrangement protocol has been applied to the entire collection. Ribbons tying bundles of letters have been retained in the collection, though the original bundles have been dismantled to facilitate access and preservation. In several instances, greeting cards were separated from general correspondence and continue to be housed in separate folders. Correspondence is not divided other than by year, and letters continue to be housed in their original envelopes (if they survive).

Personal Papers

In general, all categories in the Personal Papers sub-category have been artificially created. However, as with Correspondence, when a pattern of arrangement dating to the Young Family could be discerned it has been retained. Many Bills were organized chronologically and then alphabetically, often over a period of several years. All Bill folders arranged chronologically and alphabetically are original to the Young period. All bills arranged chronologically but not alphabetically have been sorted by the museum. Cancelled Checks have also been organized chronologically, as they were organized by the Young family. All other subject categories in Personal Papers have been artificially created by staff.

According to several staff members, Board of Trustees President Kenneth Hasbrouck destroyed some of Mrs. Young's letters and diaries in the late 1970's to "protect her privacy" though it is not known how many documents this weeding affected.

Many of Martha Young's diaries were burned by her daughter, Annette Young, on September 21, 1957, according to one of Annette Young's own diary notes. Presumably, this reference concerns diaries created after 1906, as Mrs. Young's earlier diaries do survive.
